Home Study and Post Release Services

The Home Study and Post Release Services (HS/PRS) program is a nationwide approach to guarantee the ongoing support as well as the long term safety, success and well-being of unaccompanied children (UC) prior, during and after they have been released from the Office of Refugee Resettlement (ORR) to parents or sponsors. Via a bilingual team of case managers and clinicians, Cayuga Centers provides the following services to ensure the ongoing success and stability of children in our care.

Services

- Assessment of the home and potential sponsor for any safety risks or red flags prior to unification
- Coordinate access to services such as legal representation, medical providers, community resources and advocacy
- Counseling and coaching in a case-by-case basis when instances of gang relations and substance abuse are present
- Therapeutic services to assist with individual mental health needs, family stabilization and counseling when needed
- Assistance with navigating the educational system due to possible language barriers
- Application assistance for Trafficking Victim Assistance Programs (TVAP)

Unaccompanied children between the ages of 0 and 18 can be referred to the home study and post release services program via shelter and Treatment Foster Care providers.
